Applicants to 4th Year:

Applications invited from candidates into the 4th year of the Undergraduate Architecture course at School of Architecture at the University of Limerick (SAUL). Candidates must submit a University of Limerick Undergraduate Studies Application Form, together with a Statement of Motivation and two references from your current academic tutors. Applicants will have successfully completed at least 3 years of study in a Level 8 accredited degree programme in Architecture.

Statement of Motivation

The statement of motivation must give evidence of your ambitions, interests, and approach within the study of architecture. The statement of motivation should also identify your reasons for wishing to join the School of Architecture at UL.

Candidates may subsequently be invited to interview.

Portfolio

If selected for interview candidates must bring a portfolio of work. Interviews are expected to take place by mid-July. The portfolio should demonstrate the candidate's project work from years 1, 2, and 3 completed within an accredited school of architecture. It is useful to be able to see the process of work through the project design development, sketchbooks, models, and any related self-motivated works. Though portfolios are composed principally of work done in the context of the academic architectural programme, we encourage the submission of other works done peripherally to course work.

Closing date for receipt of completed applications is 4th June 2010.
