

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the 2007-2008 edition of *Careers by Degrees*, a guide to career opportunities for UL graduates. This publication provides information on more than 100 organisations targeting UL students for recruitment in 2008. It is also a guide to the UL Careers Fair, with details of more than 100 employers who have booked to attend this major event, which will be held on campus on Thursday 18 October 2007.

UL graduates can be found in all sectors of the economy and have earned a very good reputation amongst employers. The annual surveys of the first destinations of Irish graduates show that the employment record of UL graduates is higher than the national average for all Irish graduates. Finding employment is not easy, however, and it requires planning, preparation and persistence. Competition for the more attractive and interesting jobs is always very keen and, if you want to maximize your chances of finding your ideal job, you need to start now and plan your job search carefully.

The UL Careers Service, part of the Cooperative Education & Careers Division, organises a very full programme of career events during your final year to help you make a successful transition into the world of work. Details of all the careers advisory services available to students can be found on the Careers Website at: www.ul.ie/careers, or in the Careers Guide which was posted to all final-year students. Additional copies are available in the new Careers Service office in E0019 (opposite the main Coop office).

This publication, *Careers by Degrees*, focuses specifically on employment opportunities. It may not include your ideal job, but don't despair. The employers mentioned in this publication are those who plan their recruitment campaign in advance and these are the minority. Many employers only advertise positions as they become available. We will publicise these vacancies in the Jobs section of the Careers Website, and on the Careers notice boards throughout the year. Make a point of keeping up to date with the job market by checking the website regularly.

I hope you find this publication a useful resource as you make the transition from education to employment.

EMPLOYERS ON CAMPUS 2007/2008

What is the Graduate Milkround?

During the academic year, we invite employers to hold presentations on campus as part of their graduate recruitment activity. The term often used for these presentations is the 'Milkround'. The purpose of these presentations is to provide first-hand information to students on the range of career options available in any particular company. Normally, these presentations take place in advance of the application deadline, and employers outline the selection procedure in detail. First interviews usually take place on campus sometime after the presentation.

The busiest time of the year, in terms of graduate recruitment activity, is the period from October to December. This is because many of the large employers commence their recruitment campaign early in the final year, as competition for good graduates is quite keen. These presentations are geared towards final-year or postgraduate students who are actively seeking employment for when they graduate. Many employers, however, recruit on a year-round basis, and we continue to organise presentations in the spring semester.

What to expect at presentations

To accommodate students, these presentations usually take place in the evening, at 6.30 p.m., or sometimes on Wednesday afternoons. The format varies, but usually includes a presentation by the company, followed by a question and answer session. Many companies bring recent graduates to speak about their own experiences. In some cases, the presentations are followed by a reception that allows students to mingle with company representatives. The duration of the presentations varies, but most are over within one hour. Most of these presentations are quite informal, but some employers, particularly accounting firms, use the presentations as an integral part of their selection procedure, and issue invitations to selected candidates. In these cases, it is advisable to treat the presentation almost like an interview, and dress accordingly.

Why attend presentations?

It is advisable to attend as many presentations as you can, as they provide an ideal opportunity to inform yourself of the different career options available. They also provide insight into a company's policies and recruitment practices. We advertise presentations on the Careers Notice Boards one week in advance of the date. For details of presentations this semester, check the Calendar of Events in the Careers Website at: www.ul.ie/careers.

What about other employers?

Not all the companies who recruit graduates are mentioned in this publication. We contacted over 900 employers during the summer period, and those who provided us with a profile of their graduate requirements are included. Others will notify us of vacancies throughout the year, so it is vital that you continue to check the Career Website (Jobs section) on a regular basis for updates. You should also consult the Gradireland Directory (details of graduate opportunities in Ireland), copies of which are available from the Careers Service in E0019. Another valuable source of employer information is the official Irish graduate website at: www.gradireland.com. The UL Careers Website also provides links to employers' own websites. This can be accessed in the Jobs section under 'Links to Employers'.

UL CAREERS FAIR – THURSDAY 18 OCTOBER 2007

The Cooperative Education & Careers Division is organising a major on-campus Careers Fair on 18 October 2007. This follows on from the success of similar events held in previous years, and is expected to be equally popular, with more than 100 companies already registered to participate, making it the largest of any careers fairs in Irish universities. The Fair will take place in the Sports Arena, and will be open to students from 12.00 until 4.00 p.m. Many sectors of employment will be represented, so it should be of interest to all students. Another event with a different emphasis, the Spring Fair, will be held on campus on Wednesday 5 March 2008, and a specialist Teaching Fair will also be held on Wednesday 12 March 2008. Details will be advertised on the Careers website.

What's it all about?

For those of you who have never attended a Careers Fair (or Recruitment Fair), this provides you with a unique opportunity to meet with a number of employers who plan to recruit UL graduates in 2008. Some of these employers will also have immediate vacancies to fill. Representatives of these companies will describe their organisation and typical vacancies, with a view to encouraging you to apply when vacancies arise.

Why should you attend?

The UL Careers Fair gives you the opportunity to:

- Make personal contact with leading graduate recruiters
- Get expert advice on what a career with a particular company might involve and how to apply for that job
- Collect company literature and information to help you compare companies
- Determine which organisation you would like to join

Be Prepared!

To make the best of this opportunity, you will need to be prepared. Few employers will offer you a job on the spot, but if you make the right impression, this will be to your advantage at the interview stage. Here are some tips to help you on the day:

- Do some research on companies you want to check out. Read the company entries in this publication carefully and check the company websites.
- For help in preparing a CV or online application, attend the seminar on 'Making Effective Applications' on October 1st.
- Attend the seminar on 'Preparing for the Careers Fair' on October 11th.
- Book a slot to have your CV checked at the lunch-time CV Review sessions in E0019 the week beginning October 8th.
- Take along several copies of your CV to give to employers.
- Think about your skills, qualifications & experience that might interest employers
- Think about what questions you want to ask them: What vacancies do they have? What are their requirements? What training opportunities do they offer?
- Be sure to visit the less well-known organisations also as they often have very challenging opportunities to offer.
- Make note of the names of any contacts you make on the day.

In summary:

The UL Careers Fair is an ideal opportunity to make contact with a significant number of employers who have real jobs to offer. By preparing for the event, you stand a better chance of using the time and opportunity effectively. Know what you want from the fair, know what you have to offer, and be prepared to consider everything. This is your chance to make some useful contacts and see what opportunities are out there...SO DON'T MISS OUT!

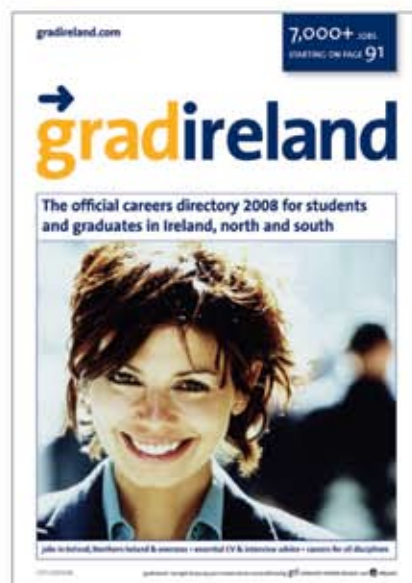
