Transportation:

The University of Limerick is located 31km from Shannon International Airport. The cost of hiring a taxi from Shannon Airport to University of Limerick is approximately €40.

From Shannon you can travel by bus to Limerick. Journey time from Shannon to Limerick, a distance of 24km, is about forty minutes on the bus (operates from 06.45 – midnight) while the journey time from Limerick to the University is about twenty minutes on the bus. The adult bus fare from Shannon Airport to Limerick City is €6.80 one-way and €11.30 return. There is a reduction offered to students.

There is a regular bus service between the campus and the city centre. A bus ticket costs € 1.60. From the bus stop near the Centra shop in William St. take the bus for the University or Plassey (usually a no.308 or no.302 bus).

For those who are not arriving into Shannon Airport, a taxi to the University from Limerick City (c. 5km from the City Centre) will cost approximately €10.00.

If you are driving from Shannon Airport to the University as you leave Shannon follow signs on the dual carriageway for Limerick City **N18**. When you reach the Ennis Road Roundabout at the end of the dual carriageway, take the **N7** signposted Dublin. Take the Dublin Road out of the city and travel approx two miles to the Parkway roundabout. Go straight through at this roundabout. At the next roundabout, turn left and follow the signs for the University. **(Please note that parking outside of designated car parks will result in clamping. There is a charge of € 25.00 to have the clamp removed)**

For delegates flying to Dublin airport, JJ Kavanagh & Sons provide coach services that link Dublin airport and Shannon airport regularly each day. These coaches depart from Dublin airport and stop on the University of Limerick campus. For further details, please see <http://www.jjkavanagh.ie/>.

GENERAL

Climate

Ireland has a temperate climate, resulting in relatively cool summers. The mean daily temperature in June is 15 - 20°C. It is generally quite dry in June but you may experience some rain, so come prepared!

Electricity Supply

The domestic electricity supply in Ireland is AC 230v 50 hz. Electrical plugs are the same as those used in the UK. You are advised to purchase the appropriate adapters in advance. These are available at most airports.

Banking

There is one bank located on campus (Ulster Bank). Banking hours are from 10.00 - 16.00 every day. ATM machines are located in the student centre on campus. Generally, banking hours in Limerick City are 10.00 -16.00.

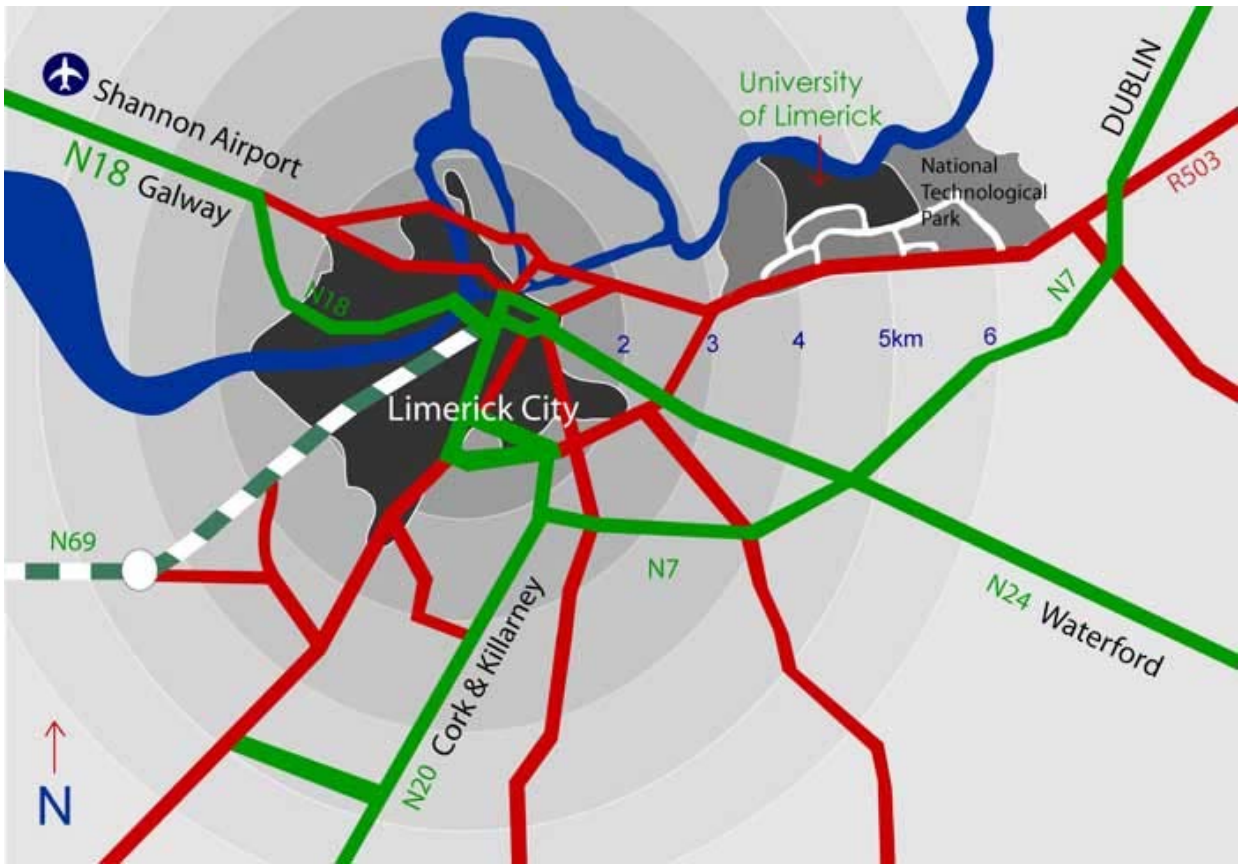
